It has been informed that the trial against the accused is going on and out of 10 PWs cited, the prosecution has examined 02 PWs so far with next date of hearing being 22.04.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, however, a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a fixed time frame.

Under the circumstances, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The trial Court is directed to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial within a period of 06 months from today, by giving short adjournments, refusing to grant adjournment except for justifiable reasons, which are to be recorded in the order. The State counsel shall cause appearance of PWs on the date(s) so fixed. Of course, no unnecessary adjournment would be asked on behalf of the accused for the purpose of cross-examination of PWs, if trial is to proceed expeditiously.
