This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.143 dated 25.08.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 323, 427, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, & under Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Taran Taran. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

This Court while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State on 23.01.2020 had extended the interim protection to the petitioner.

The said order reads as under:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the interim concession was given by the Court of Sessions. As the petitioner failed to join the investigation, the bail application was dismissed on 04.11.2019. Further, reliance is placed upon the order dated 20.01.2020 passed in CRM-M No.2086 of 2020*

*(Dilbagh Singh @ Baga Versus State of Punjab).*

*Notice of motion for 21.04.2020.*

*Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

*To be heard along with CRM-M No.2086 of 2020.”*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by SI Amrik Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.01.2020 is made absolute.
