SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.133 dated 03.11.2019 under Sections 324, 323, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 307 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

On 23.01.2020, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was a cross fight and cross case vide DDR dated 04.11.2019 was registered on the statement of petitioner. He has further submits that the injury attributed to the petitioner is a simple injury on left arm of complainant Jagjit Singh.

Notice of motion for 31.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions, from ASI, Jaspal Singh, Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 23.01.2020 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
