The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.329 dated 28.11.2018 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.

On 23.01.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that due to wrong recording of date as 29.11.2019 in place of 28.11.2019, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court. Bail earlier granted to the petitioner has been cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds have been forfeited. Non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner for 06.02.2020.

Notice of motion for 27.03.2020.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 06.02.2020. In the event of his appearance, he shall be granted interim bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

In compliance of the afore-said order, learned counsel for the petitioner has sent a copy of order dated 06.02.2020 passed by the Additional District & Sessions Judge-IV, Jalandhar to show that the petitioner had appeared before the concerned Court and has been granted interim bail.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the the aforesaid fact.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 23.01.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on appearing before the trial Court regularly.

Petition stands disposed of.
