The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference (V.C.) due to COVID-19 situation.

There is a request received for an adjournment on behalf of the petitioner on WhatsApp group created for V.C.

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.2 dated 7.1.2021 under Sections 323, 325, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

This Court vide order dated 29.1.2021 granted interim bail subject to joining investigation. The order is reproduced below:

"Heard.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 14.07.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of one week and on his doing so, in the event of arrest the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C."

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is co-operating.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the interim bail granted on 29.1.2021 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
