The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.323 dated 11.12.2019 under Section 323, 506, 328, 498-A, 147 and 149 IPC 1860 (Section 406 added later on while Sections 147, 149 and 328 IPC were deleted) registered at Police Station Sadar District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is essentially a matrimonial dispute between the parties, which has been given a criminal complexion by the complainant. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 24.01.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jaswinder states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 24.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
