This petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India has been moved seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and to decide representation dated 28.12.2020 (Annexure P/1).

Learned counsel for petitioner contended that petitioner is a lady aged 75 years and she is seeking protection of her life and liberty from her sons (respondents No.4 and 5) and her daughters-in-law (respondents No.6 and 7) as they are threatening her to transfer her property in their favour. He further urges that petitioner has already made representation dated 28.12.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Batala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.
