This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.123 dated 06.11.2020, registered under Sections 304, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar (Rural) (Annexure P-1) by handing over the investigation to a senior police officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Takwinder Singh, has stated that there are in all six accused persons and all of them have been arrested. According to her, the final report against one of the accused, namely, Kashmir Singh has been filed, whereas the investigation in respect of rest of the accused is almost complete and the final report is likely to be filed before the Court of competent jurisdiction, in near future.

Considering the above stage of the investigation in the above FIR, this Court is not inclined to exercise the inherent powers under Section

482 Cr.P.C. at this stage.
