The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.104 dated 19.06.2020 registered
under Sections 420, 406 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.1,
district Pathankot.

On 29.01.2021 this Court had passed the following order : -

“Case taken up through Video Conferencing.

*Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia
contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in
the case; the tractor in question had been purchased by
co-accused – Hira Singh and it is he who has defaulted in
making the balance payment for the tractor; there is no
reason for the tractor to be in possession of the petitioner;
co-accused – Hira Singh has been granted regular bail by
the Trial Court; there is no other criminal case in which
the petitioner is involved and that the petitioner is ready*

and willing to join investigation as and when called by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 11.05.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.104, dated 19.06.2020, registered under Sections 420, 406, 120B IPC at Police Station Division No.1, District Pathankot, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer."

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 29.01.2021 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
