The petitioner has filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 09.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to decide the aforesaid representation dated 09.01.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Heard.

Without making any observation as regard the claim so made in the present petition, but considering the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take note of the representation dated 09.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) regarding protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner and to act in accordance with law.
