GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against her vide FIR No.263 dated 22.12.2019 at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 406/420 IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably resolved amongst the parties and in fact a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has also been filed in this Court.
3. On the other hand, learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the aforestated position wherein the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties and it has been informed that a quashing petition has already been filed on the basis of compromise and the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation, her custodial interrogation is not warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 23.01.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
