Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his car i.e. Audi bearing registration No.CH01AL-6070 was taken away by respondent No.6 – Jagjit Singh and is being illegally retained. It has been submitted that although the petitioner lodged an FIR against respondent No.6 and the factum of the car being in possession of Jagjit Singh was verified, as would be evident from a perusal of status report filed by way of an affidavit of Mr. Raj Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, in CRM-M-33122-2020, but till date his car has not been recovered. It has been submitted that although the petitioner served a legal notice dated 10.12.2020 (Annexure P-6) to respondents No.2 & 3, but to no avail.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Commissioner of Police, Panchkula to

look into the matter and to dispose of the legal notice dated 10.12.2020 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law expeditiously.

A copy of this order alongwith legal notice (Annexure P-6) be sent to respondent No.3 – Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
