The petitioner is aggrieved, because, his representations dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) and 6.1.2021 (Annexure P-5) have not been responded to. He alleges that he is 80% handicapped on account of amputation of one arm. The second arm is also deficient and thus, he needs extra-time for the departmental promotion examination as well as the services of a scribe.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to fourth respondent to decide the pending representations.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the all respondents and waives service.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to file a written statement, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to decide the representations dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) and 6.1.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, within

seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Necessary assistance be provided to the petitioner, in case, Rules permit.
