Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.646 dated 02.11.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station SGM Nagar, District Faridabad.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 19.02.2020: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the affidavit of the petitioner and his brother, who is also stated to be having the same name, i.e. Dalip Singh. Prima facie, these documents show that the date of birth of the petitioner is 15.9.1974, whereas the date of birth of his brother Dalip Singh is 15.9.1965. Affidavit

dated 18.2.2020 and photocopies of Identity Card, Aadhar Card, Voter Card etc. are taken on record...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation. It is further submitted that a period of about 01 year and 08 months has passed and there is no complaint against the petitioner that he has misused the concession of interim anticipatory bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.02.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
