Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.152 dated 29.12.2020 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 11.02.2021, arrest of the petitioner was stayed subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Dilpreet Singh, the petitioner has taken money for sending him abroad and in that process, some agreement to sell was also executed. It is further submitted that in compliance of the

aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Investigating Officer/SI Barjinder Singh, Additional SHO, Police Station Doraha, Sub Division Payal, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, in compliance of the order dated 11.02.2021, in the Court today, in which it is stated that the complainant approached the petitioner for sending him abroad, for which the disputed amount was paid. With regard to agreement to sell dated 21.06.2019, it is stated that affidavit is not a genuine document.

In reply, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the agreement to sell is subject matter of the civil suit and its validity is yet to be ascertained.

Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and on instructions from SI Gurjinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.02.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
