1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 29.09.2017 registered under Sections 379-B, 34 and 201 IPC, at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 11.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Jagdish Singh* confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 11.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the investigation, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of the learned AAG, Punjab, order dated 11.02.2021 passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
