The grievance of the petitioner is that despite repeated applications and representations, his arms licence issued in the year 2002 has not been renewed. Even legal notice dated 17.11.2020 (Annexure P-3) has not been responded to.

In view of the nature of the controversy, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to decide the pending legal notice dated 17.11.2020 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order.

Thus, it is not essential to issue notice to the respondents.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending legal notice dated 17.11.2020 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
