The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 273, dated 29.09.2020, under Sections 22, 25, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the averments made in the instant petition, no ground is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, as *prima facie*, there are serious allegations against the petitioner for being in possession of 6100 intoxicating tablets of Alprazolam and 9300 intoxicating tablets of Tramwel 100 SR, which falls under the category of 'commercial quantity'. Moreover the petitioner was apprehended along with the contraband on the basis of a secret information received by the police party in which he was specifically named.

Learned State counsel has also submitted that the investigation in the present case is still underway and challan is yet to be presented.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, no ground is made out to extend the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Consequently, finding no merit in the instant petition, same stands dismissed. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
