Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.223 dated 29.12.2020, under Section 498-A, 323 IPC, Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 29.12.2020.

The allegations contained in the FIR as noticed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali in his order dated 13.1.2021, are as under:-

“FIR in this case was got registered by complainant Renu on the allegations that her marriage was solemnized in the year 2014 with applicant-accused Surinder Singh Gill and they have one male child from the said wedlock. It has been averred that her husband have illicit relations with many girls and used to harass her under the effect of alcohol. It is further averred that on 28.12.2020, he gave beatings to her by consuming liquor. She has raised allegations of physical harassment, maltreatment, torture and beatings. Upon

these allegations, the present FIR has been lodged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that during the pendency of the investigation of the above FIR, the complainant has compromised the dispute with the petitioner and they both have decided to reunite and live together.

At this stage, Mr. Sanchit Luthra, Advocate, learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 has filed his memo of appearance and does not dispute the above fact.

Considering the above background and the nature of offence, the prayer is accepted and it is ordered that the petitioner be released on regular bail in the above case, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.

The petition is allowed.
