ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, the petitioners pray for quashing of FIR No.74 dated 09.07.2017 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 458, 323, 506 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, for, the dispute between the parties stands amicably resolved and a compromise dated 05.01.2021 (Annexure P-2), in this regard has since been effected.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that even though petitioners had already been convicted by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nabha, but, purely, owing to an inadvertent and *bona fide* error this fact was not mentioned in the petition. Though, it is duly reflected in paragraph 1 of the compromise/settlement deed appended with the petition (Annexure P-2). He submits, for, the appeal filed by the petitioners against conviction is pending before the Sessions Court, Patiala,

the petitioners be permitted to withdraw this petition, for, they shall take up all the necessary pleas in relation to the alleged compromise/settlement (ibid) before the appellate Court itself.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
