Main case

The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to take action against the elected office bearers of the Gram Panchayat, Village Pippal Majra, Tehsil Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar. The petitioner has prayed for the following substantive reliefs:-

- I. Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of writ of mandamus thereby directing the official respondents to remove the respondent no.5 to from their post as they suffer a disqualification and for causing huge loss to the Gram

Panchayat and the government further for initiating proceedings against government officials and private persons who have acted in hand in glove illegal encroachment over panchayat land as per Law.

II. Further prayer for issuance of such other appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus to implement recommendation give vide letter dated 07.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) as per law within stipulated period by appointment some independent and impartial officials for the same.”

Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, AAG, Punjab, has stated that the Director, Panchayat, Punjab, has sought a report from the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Punjab, in this regard and action shall be taken in accordance with law, the moment the report is received.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to request the Director, Panchayat, Punjab, to pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
