The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0090 dated 29.12.2020 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women, District District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present FIR was registered against the petitioner on account of a marital discord between the parties and the matter stands amicably settled between the parties. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 03.02.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant on instructions from the investigating officer, has

conceded that in compliance of order dated 03.02.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required in the case.

Report from the Mediation and Conciliation Center too has been received. As per the report, the matter stands amicably settled between the parties.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 03.02.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
