This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 read with Article 21 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 14 with further direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide representation dated 15.01.2021 (Annexure P/1) in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 15.01.2021 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Saurav Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, to look into and decide representation dated 15.01.2021 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
