The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

The respondent No.4 in the case is the husband of the petitioner and respondent No.5 is the mother-in-law.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case a detailed affidavit of Ravinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Mukerian, Distt. Hoshiarpur dated 10.02.2021 has been filed, in which it has been specifically stated that initially respondent Nos.4 and 5 were under the impression that the petitioner was missing but however, they have learnt that the petitioner had filed the present case on 27.01.2021, they have given statements that they will not interfere and petitioner can live

wherever she wants to live and the said statements are annexed along with the said reply.

In view of the reply made nothing survives in the present petition and the present petition is thus, disposed of being rendered as infructuous. It has further been stated that even respondent Nos.6 and 7 have given a statement to the same effect.

Keeping in view, the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered as infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move a representation before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur in case of any apprehension regarding threat perception of life and liberty in future and in case such a representation is moved then respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
