MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By means of this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India, petitioners have prayed for a writ of mandamus by way of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty, as they have solemnized marriage on 28.01.2021 against the wishes of private respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners are receiving threats from the private respondents, as they have solemnized marriage on 28.01.2021 against their wishes. He has drawn the attention of the Court to the representation dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) submitted by petitioners to Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib and contended that no action has been taken by the officer so far. He prays for issuance of necessary directions.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the petitioners have solemnized marriage on 28.01.2021 at Panchkula and on the same day, they had given representation (Annexure P-

4) to Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib. In the petition neither any specific threat or allegation has been attributed to any of the respondents nor any convincing material has been brought on record to substantiate the ground.

The sequence of events pleaded by the petitioners in their petition do not seem to be probable. Therefore, the prayer made by the learned counsel for issuance of directions to Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into their representation is also not worth acceptance, as it also lacks all kinds of necessary particulars regarding manner and mode of alleged threat.

Resultantly, this Court is not inclined to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
