The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 232 dated 20.12.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120 B IPC and under Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 at Police Station Model Town, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued to State. Vide order dated 24.1.2020 petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel submitted that petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 24.1.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
