The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents No. 2 to 6 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents No. 7 to 13.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present case, an enquiry was conducted and in the said enquiry, it was found that there is some dispute of land between the parties herein, regarding which a civil suit had been filed and is pending and the parties were thereby advised to pursue the civil litigation for any relief that they are seeking.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with

liberty to seek alternate remedies, in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforesaid.
