1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0015 dated 07.01.2021 registered under Sections 7 & 10, Essential Commodities Act 1955 and Section 420 IPC at Police Station Mujesar, District Faridabad, Haryana.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 02.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from *ASI Rajender*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 02.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of the learned DAG, Haryana, order

dated 02.02.2021, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
