1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

3. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.345 dated 22.10.2020, registered under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498-A, 506 of IPC, at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

4. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 08.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from *HC Manoj*, informs that compromise has been arrived at between the petitioner and

respondent No.2/wife-Rajni and that respondent No.2 wants to reside along with the petitioner in the matrimonial home. Learned counsel further confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 08.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

6. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Haryana, order dated 08.02.2021, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
