The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.03 dated 11.01.2021 registered under Sections 304, 336 IPC and under Section 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

During investigation, the police has recorded statements of Jagsir Singh and Raja Singh on 11.01.2021 wherein they have disclosed that the petitioner was having .22 bore licensed revolver and was firing shots in the air in the Lohri

function under the influence of liquor. Relatives and villagers were resisting him.

One of the gun shots hit Harjit Singh, which ultimately proved fatal.

The matter is still under investigation.

No case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
