MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By means of this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India, petitioners have prayed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 7, as they have solemnized marriage on 28.01.2021 against their wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners are known to each other for the last three years who fell in love and decided to marry. According to him, the alliance of the petitioners being inter-religion was opposed by parents of Pooja (petitioner No.1) and therefore, they performed marriage on 28.01.2021 against their wishes. He submits that the petitioners are receiving threats from the parents of Pooja and they had given representation dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P-3) to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, but till date no action has been taken. He prays that necessary directions be issued to official respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court finds that the representation was given on 25.01.2021 and the alleged

marriage took place on 28.01.2021. The apprehension expressed by the petitioners is not supported by any convincing material, particularly when their relations or the marriage ceremony performed on 28.01.2021 were never obstructed by the private respondents. Apart from this, the relevant details and particulars of the alleged phone calls made by the parents of the petitioner No.1 are neither contained in the writ petition nor in the representation.

Since the averments in the writ petition are vague, therefore, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercising the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
