By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner are seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 569, dated 03.10.2019, under Sections 498-A, 323, 313, 406, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 – complainant has submitted that there has been yet again non-compliance of the order dated 02nd August, 2021 of this Court, vide which the petitioner had been directed to pay a sum of Rs. 20,000/- to respondent No.2 on her appearance before the the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, as litigation expenses.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has apprised the Court that despite their repeated attempts to get in touch with the

petitioner and apprise him about the orders of this Court, they have been unable to get in touch with him, as he has failed to revert to them.

In the circumstances and keeping in view the allegations levelled against the petitioner of subjecting the complainant-wife to continuous mental and physical harassment, this Court does not deem it appropriate to extend the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
