Petitioner – Shriram Parsad, JE, stated to be aged 59 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the GP funds of the petitioner as he was retired on 27.02.2017 as per Annexure P-2.

Records of the case show that vide order dated 02.02.2021, notice of motion was issued.

CM No.2120 of 2021 has been filed by the applicant-petitioner *inter alia* with a prayer to allow the petitioner to withdraw the present writ petition.
