Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.138 dated 27.12.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 18.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
