The petitioner prays for a certiorari to quash the instructions dated 28.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to command the respondents to renew the trade certificates issued to the petitioner and other associate dealers appointed directly by the manufacturer of the automobiles as also to quash the order dated 13.05.2020 (Annexure P-4) vide which the authorities have declined renewal of the trade certificates of the petitioner.

2. It is urged that even a representation/legal notice dated 10.10.2020 (Annexure P-5) the authorities have been served with has failed to evoke any response.

3. In response, Mr. Deepak Balyan, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana submits for the representation/legal notice (ibid) submitted by the petitioner is already pending consideration before the authorities, the same shall be dealt with at the earliest.

4. In the wake of the statement made by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, we consider it expedient to dispose of the petition requiring the respondents to consider and decide the representation/legal notice (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and appropriate orders thereon be passed expeditiously.
