Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to re-examine the forensic science laboratory (FSL) report (Annexure P-3) through medical board at Forensic Science Laboratory Madhuban (Karnal) in case FIR No.11 dated 10.01.2019 for the offences under Section 376/323 and 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station Nuh, District Nuh (Mewat).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has come up with self contradictory statements. On the one hand, he seems to be casting doubt on the authenticity of the report received from FSL with respect to semen not having been found on the case property, which was sent to it and on the other hand, learned counsel is seeking to send the very same sample to some other agency for re-examination.

Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the State and has apprised the Court that in fact Cancellation Report already stands presented before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned on

19.02.2020.

In the circumstances, this Court is not inclined to exercise its inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.PC. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed. However, petitioner is at liberty to avail of any alternate remedy as may be available to her under the provisions of law.
