MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (Oral)

1. This is the first petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.138, dated 13.11.2019, registered under Sections 304-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ram Nagar, District Karnal, Haryana which was restricted/converted into the prayer on the last date of hearing for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for getting treatment of his daughter.

2. In compliance of the order dated 25.03.2021, passed by this Court, learned State counsel has placed on record through email the relevant document including opinion of the treating doctor regarding the medical ailment, investigations and treatment of the petitioner's daughter namely; Lavya, aged 4 years who is stated to be suffering from Congenital Spine

Deformity. The same are taken on record subject to just exceptions. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner, who has been in custody since 13.11.2019, is the only male member in the family and being father of the child not only would his presence be required but he would also have to arrange for finances for the medical tests, investigations and treatment of his daughter. Hence, the petitioner may be granted concession of interim regular bail.

4. A perusal of the documents so placed on record reveal that the investigations which are to be carried out on the child are extensive and may have to be done under general anaesthesia.

5. Heard.

6. In view of the aforesaid, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender back to the Jail, where he is currently lodged, on 17.04.2021 by 5.00 P.M positively.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
