Vide an order dated 07.03.2020, impugned herein, passed by the learned MACT in the course of execution proceedings, request of the petitioner (widow of the deceased victim) to release the compensation awarded to her, which was directed to be kept in Fixed Deposit for a period of two years, has been declined.

2. Direction to keep the part compensation in fixed deposit was given by this court at the time of disposing of appeal bearing FAO No. 9346 of 2014, filed by the petitioner herself seeking enhancement of compensation. Her said appeal was disposed in the following terms:

“Total compensation is Rs.8,26,000/- and the additional amount is Rs.2,51,000/- (8,26,000 - 5,75,000), payable with interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till realization, except for the period of delay of 856 days in filing the appeal, to be invested in fixed deposit for a period of two years.

The appeal is partly allowed in the aforesaid terms.”

3. The order passed in the FAO has attained finality as the same was never challenged any further. Accordingly, the prayer of the petitioner seeking release of the compensation lying in the Fixed Deposit pursuant to the orders

passed by this Court is accepted. The Executing Court shall release the same within a period of one week on the petitioner approaching the Executing Court by way of appropriate application, appending the web print of the instant order.
