The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.716 dated 09.09.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that there is a delay of 03 days in reporting the matter. An altercation had taken place as the complainant had misbehaved with the daughter of petitioner No.1. He also contends that with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised. A copy of the compromise is annexed as Annexure P-3.

This Court, by order dated 03.02.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 03.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
