Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 746 dated 25.09.2020, registered under Sections 416, 420, 467, 468, 469, 471, 506, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station City, District Panipat.

At the very outset, learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has raised an objection that vide order dated 27.01.2021, the petitioner was granted interim bail by the Sessions Judge, Panipat in view of the fact that he tested positive for COVID-19 and the petitioner, after availing the interim bail, has not surrendered back so far.

On 20.04.2021, the case was adjourned for today directing learned counsel for the petitioner to ascertain whether the petitioner has surrendered back or not.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate and submitted that petitioner has not surrendered so far after availing the interim bail.

The aforesaid facts are not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the conduct of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed.
