The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No.03 dated 18.05.2020, under Sections 307 and 324 IPC, registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala in FIR No.58 dated 18.05.2020, under Sections 307 and 324 IPC, registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is case of version and cross-version. One person of the petitioner's party had lost his life in the incident. The injuries which are attributed to the petitioner are on non-vital parts of the body of the injured.

This Court, by order dated 18.03.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 18.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
