This is third petition for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 50 dated 14.04.2019 registered under Sections 21- 22-61-85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Vairo Ke, District Fazilka

On 28.10.2020, the following order was passed by this Court, while dismissing the second petition for grant of bail filed by the petitioner:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.50 dated 14.04.2019 registered under Sections 21- 22-61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985(hereinafter to be referred as “the Act of 1985”) at Police Station Vairo Ke, District Fazilka.

First petition was dismissed on
11.09.2019

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 1020 intoxicating tablets of CLOVIDOL-100-SR containing Tramadol Hydrochloride. She was also found in possession of 5 gm heroin. It is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner that she already stands convicted in two cases under the Act of 1985. It is further stated that there is yet another case pending against the petitioner apart from the present one.

Hence, no ground to grant bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed”

Learned counsel for the petitioner failed to make out any new ground for grant of bail.

Hence, dismissed.
