Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.555 dated 07.12.2020, under Section 379-A IPC, registered at Police Station City, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged that the petitioners had snatched the gold chain of the complainant. He, however, contends that the petitioners were involved merely on suspicion and the complainant has filed affidavit in which it is stated that the petitioners were not involved. He also contends that the petitioners are poor ladies and are in custody for over 03 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioners, who are ladies, are in custody for over 03 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the

conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
