The present petition has filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory to the petitioner in FIR No.80 dated 11.07.2018, under Sections 21, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

On 27.01.2020 notice of motion was issued in this case and on 19.02.2020 the petitioner was directed to surrender in the trial Court within a period of 7 days and on her doing so, the trial Court was to release the petitioner on interim bail. On 07.09.2021 the learned counsel for the petitioner had made a request for adjournment and on 28.09.2021 the learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted he was not able to contact the petitioner as to whether she has appeared before the trial Court or not and same was the position with the learned State counsel as he was not able to

seek instructions.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has not contacted him and, therefore, he is not aware of the factual position. However, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh has submitted that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court on 19.02.2020, the petitioner has not surrendered before the trial Court as directed by this Court.

In view of the instructions obtained by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has not complied with the orders passed by this Court, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
