The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.14 dated 10.01.2021 under Sections 323, 354, 452, 506 and 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Hansi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 03rd February 2021 passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in the following terms, the petitioner has joined investigation.

“The allegation against the petitioner is that he entered the house of the prosecutrix with some bad intention and started misbehaving with her. Notice of motion for 12.05.2021. Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be

released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C”

Learned State counsel on instructions from WHC Suman states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 03rd February 2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
