Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.198 dated 18.08.2020, under Sections 324, 323, 341, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was armed with a 'dang' and only a simple injury has been attributed to him. He also contends that co-accused Sukhbeer Singh and Surjit Singh @ Kala have been granted anticipatory by this Court in CRM-M-34421-2020 and CRM-M-38680-2020 on 22.12.2020 and 08.01.2021 respectively.

This Court, by the order dated 03.02.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 03.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
