Petitioner has filed this third petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0155 dated 20.02.2019 under Sections 5/13 (2) and 17 of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, Sections 11, 59 and 60 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, Sections 279, 336, 186, 353, 307 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh, Mewat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the co-accused of the petitioner have been released on anticipatory bail, therefore, concession of pre-arrest bail be extended to the petitioner as well.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the first application filed by the petitioner for the anticipatory bail was dismissed on merits vide order dated 03.07.2019 and thereafter, another application was filed by him, which was withdrawn on 27.05.2020.

Apparently, this third petition based on the same cause of action is nothing but the misuse of the process of the Court and therefore, it is a fit case for burdening the petitioner with a costs of Rs.25,000/-.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed and it is ordered that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- with Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees' Welfare Association within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nuh shall ensure the recovery and deposit of the costs.
