Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Present petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent No.3 as they are being harassed unnecessarily by calling them to the police station frequently at the instance of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a Lance Naik in the Indian Army; that FIR No.76 dated 19.05.2020, Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana, under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, has been registered against respondents No.4 to 6 for causing injuries to Gurcharan Singh, brother of the petitioner, and that respondent No.3 is harassing the petitioner and his family members by calling them frequently to the police station in connection with the complaint filed by

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respondents No.4 to 6. It is further stated that the petitioner has to join the duty on 28.02.2021.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer-ASI Subhash, submits that the Investigating Officer has recently joined in the concerned police station and he will investigate the case, as per law and the petitioner and his family members will not be harassed unnecessarily by calling them to the police station.

In view of the submissions made by the learned State counsel during the course of hearing, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to ASI Subhash, Investigating Officer, not to harass the petitioner and his family members by calling them to the police station except in due course of law.
