Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.479 dated 06.12.2020, under Section 13(2) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 and Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, registered at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are that a pickup vehicle was stopped at the barricade and 02 persons managed to flee leaving behind cattle and a knife.

This Court, by the order dated 12.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Hakmudin, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is also involved in other cases.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
