The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.663 dated 19.10.2019 under Sections 323, 376(2)(n), 406, 506 of the IPC (Section 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 added later on) registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurugram.

It is the case of the petitioner that he had been in a live-in-relationship with the complainant and it was during this period, a loan of Rs.7 lacs had been taken by the complainant for her business. However, later on, when the relations between the parties turned sour, she lodged the FIR in question, wherein she levelled allegations against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 29th January, 2020 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner by urging that out of the total loan amount of Rs.7,00,000/- only Rs.50,000/- has been recovered.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Amandeep submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 29th January, 2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
